

A Mobile Food Pantry in Pollock served families with food and grocery distributions on the first Tuesday of each month.

Partner Agency Programs provided 261,620 pounds of food to neighbors through food pantries, meal programs and community services.

SNAP Assistance helped **57 families** complete & submit applications for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (Food Stamps).
